Priorities raised at previous Forum

- Parking generally across the area.
- Ongoing parking related issues around High Street Henley, opposite Beaudesert Lane.
- Ongoing parking related issues outside Tesco Express in Studley.

Priorities- Alcester North

Parking at Tanworth School.

We have visited the school and letters have been sent out to parents. We have spoken with local establishments regarding alternative parking areas and the school is looking to extend their car park. There is some building work currently being carried out and when this complete it will help further.

Pact Priority Work-Speeding

- Site specific data with regard to tickets issued is an exemption under the freedom of information act.
- Local speed checks have been carried out at: B4189 Claverdon, The Common Earlswood, Station Road and Toms Town Lane in Studley, Middletown Lane in Sambourne and High Street Henley in Arden. We have issued 30 warnings and 2 fixed penalties.

Antisocial behaviour in Birdcage Walk and around Medical centre Henley in Arden.

Extra police patrols have been organised to address these particular issues. An offender has been identified for a serious attack on play area on the Riverlands in Henley.



Other Current Concerns

- A series of burglaries of barns and sheds, also thefts from vehicles has occurred in and around Henley. Targeted patrols have been allocated to tackle the problem, task force and traffic officers in the main have been used.
- Youths have started to gather in Millennium Park Studley again, on Friday nights in particular and in some numbers. We are applying for a dispersal zone to tackle the situation as we believe there are a number of such zones in place in Redditch and this may be displacing problems to Studley.

Other Work



Some of the property recovered from a local site as part of Operation Crunch when we executed a warrant. Crunch is a force wide operation in respect of serious acquisitive crime offences. 3 male persons arrested, they were suspected of a series of shed and house burglaries across our police area.

Operation Orleans.

Designed to reduce incidents of ASB on lead up to and at Halloween and Bonfire night.



Alcohol was confiscated during operation and shops visited to warn of dangers of selling eggs and flour to young persons. Vulnerable people visited and preventative literature handed out.



- A Henley man was stopped in his car in Mappleborough Green in July, 25 bags of herbal cannabis were found and he has recently been convicted of possession with intent to supply. He was given a 12 month community order and a 50 hour unpaid work requirement.
