**ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2010**

**Audit Commission Act 1998, Sections 15 and 16.**

**The Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003 (SI 2003/533) as amended.**

Each year the Annual Return of Studley Parish Council is audited by an auditor appointed by the Audit Commission. Any person interested has the right to inspect the accounts and make copies of the annual return and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating to the Accounting Statements. For the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010 these documents will be available on reasonable notice on application to the Clerk Mrs Dorothy Mitchell in the Parish Office, Studley Village Hall between the hours of:

9am and 12 noon, Monday to Friday.

Commencing 17<sup>th</sup> June 2010 and ending 16<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

**Local Government Electors and their representatives have the rights to:**

- Question the auditor in writing about the Accounts; and
- Object to the Accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must be given to the auditor and a copy sent to Studley Parish Council.

The auditor can be contacted at the address below for this purpose on **26<sup>th</sup> July 2010** and until the audit has been completed.
