

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A435 BARLEY MOW ISLAND, STUDLEY

Warwickshire County Council propose to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing A435 Barley Mow Island, Studley (the junction of A435 Birmingham/Alcester Road and B4092 High Street) to all traffic. The closure is required for resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 4 March 2012 and will last for a period of 8 days, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. **However, it is anticipated that the works will only take place on Sunday 4th March and Sunday 11th March 2012.**

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available A435 Birmingham Road, A4189 Warwick Highway, A4480 The Slough/Node Hill/Bromsgrove Road, A435 Alcester Road (and in reverse order).
