Community Priorities

Warwickshire Police is obliged to protect communities from harm in line with the 'Police Priorities'.

This may mean that in exceptional circumstances SNT officers may be required to work on other policing priorities.

If this happens there will be a need to re-negotiate priorities. This will be done in liaison with the Chair and the panel.

Warwickshire Police Priorities 2009/10

To reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured

- *Reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured through road traffic collisions compared with last year*
- *Reduce the number of people killed or seriously injured as a result of violence compared with last year*
- *Detect 45% of crimes where someone is killed or seriously injured*
- *Increase the number of serious sexual offences we detect compared with last year*
- *Reduce the number of victims of aggravated burglary and robbery compared with last year*
- *Identify and charge 15 members of organised crime groups whose activities harm communities*

To reduce the number of homes burgled and vehicle crimes committed

- *Reduce the number of homes burgled and vehicles stolen by three percent compared with last year*
- *Reduce theft from vehicles by five percent compared with last year*

To improve trust and confidence

- *Local Safer Neighbourhood teams will deliver 100% of agreed policing activity that protects people from harm and supports Community Forum priorities*
- *Increase the number of victims of serious sexual offences who report crimes to us compared with last year*
- *Ensure 85% of victims are satisfied with the overall experience they receive*
- *Increase confidence (measured by survey)*

Community Priorities

- Burglaries of Dwelling houses
- Parking issues around junction of Arden Road and Castle Road Henley.
- Speeding on Kemps Green Road.

House burglaries : Agreed policing actions were to carry out 24 two hour patrols.

Since the last Forum the team have carried out 30 two hour patrols in the affected areas. These patrols have included cycle patrols, patrols during daylight and during nighttime. Also we have run an operation in conjunction with ANPR team in the area.

Parking around junction Arden Road and Castle Road
Henley : Agreed policing activity was to visit area on 24
occasions.

We have visited the area on a recorded 25 occasions
since the last Forum. Early on a meeting was held with
interested agencies. The results being an agreement to
consider extending the zig-zag lines, consideration of
introduction of a voluntary one way system, adjustment
of bus arrangements and continuation of police
presence.

Speeding on Kemps Green Road: Agreed Policing activity was to carry out 10 one hour speed checks in the area.

The team have carried out 10 one hour speed checks in the area since the last forum. The checks have been carried out at various times of the day and the highest recorded speed over all the checks was 44mph. The speed limit being 60mph.

Other work undertaken by team members since last forum.



In November we assisted Trading standards when executing a search warrant related to E-Bay sales of counterfeit vehicle manuals. A considerable quantity of the manuals and computer equipment were seized.

Other matters of interest:

PCSO Dave Martin has started working out of Henley, his time will be split between Henley town and the surrounding villages.

Op Kirby has been reintroduced in the past 3 weeks and is designed to counter and reducing overnight vehicle crime. Officers from the team have been operating in a plain car and patrolling areas with higher rates of crimes.

Following an office burglary in Earlswood in the middle of January 2010 where items were left at the scene. Enquiries were done into these items and a man has been arrested and is on police bail.

On the 24th November 2009 a burglary occurred in Wootton Wawen, a member of the Safer Neighbourhood team arrested two offenders the next day, recovered some of the property and charged two offenders with the offence.

The Studley alcohol restriction zone application is now progressing well and is out for consultation with interested parties.

A dispersal area has again been introduced in to the centre of Studley.

9 Youths have been dealt with since October for damage offences in and around Studley High Street. The latest being damage to a shop window when blood was left at the scene, a DNA profile was obtained and a male admitted the damage.
