Policing

update

Presentation by PC Bob Shaw including an update on the three priorities agreed at the last Community Forum which were:

- **Speeding – Sambourne Lane, Studley**– 10 additional patrols carried out, 2 motorists caught exceeding 30mph and dealt with by Fixed Penalty Notices and roadside cautions
- **Burglary Patrol/Vehicle Crime in Alcester North Area** – 121 patrols carried out and several arrests made some of which were in connection with thefts of heating oil.
- **Speeding – Littlewood Green, Studley**– 10 additional patrols carried out, 17 motorists caught exceeding 40mph and dealt with by Fixed Penalty Notices and roadside cautions
