Community Priorities from the 7th October 2010

- Speeding on Langley Road and B4189 in Claverdon.
- Antisocial Behaviour in Centre of Studley.
- Parking issues outside One Stop and Somerfields, Henley in Arden.

Speeding on Langley Road and B4189 in Claverdon – agreed actions were to carry out 8 speed checks.

Since the last Forum the team have carried out 8 recorded speed checks. These have been done by Community Support officers. During the period we have sent 33 warning letters. The speed offences ranging up to a top recorded speed of 47 mph.

We have also been working with County Council representatives regarding flashing signs for the area and we have also made progress in the creation of a community speed watch in the area.

Antisocial Behaviour around Studley Library and the Millennium Park. –
Agreed Policing actions were to carry out 8 directed patrols.

Since the last forum we have carried out 10 extra patrols, these have been carried out by special constables and by members of the team. These patrols have yielded little in terms of offences but the alcohol restriction zone has been utilized on a number of occasions.

Op Orleans3 was most successful on Halloween, there were no incidents of antisocial behaviour reported in Studley all day. (5 years ago there were approximately 23 in an hour and a half during the early evening.) Team members patrolled the village on bicycles, visiting known problem areas and suspects as well as victims during the day. We have been assisted by the weather of late.

Parking issues outside One Stop and Somerfields, Henley in Arden. – Agreed Policing actions were to carry 12 patrols in the area.

18 patrols have been carried out, during these patrols a total of 56 drivers have been advised regarding inconsiderate parking. One driver was given an endorsable ticket for parking on the zig zags of the pedestrian crossing.

We have worked with Cllr Jem Jones in attempt to increase support from District council enforcement officers in ticketing the offenders.
