Introduction

This leaflet has been produced by Studley Parish Council and details the costs and services provided by the Council.

The Council has issued a Precept or charge of £122,528 on Stratford District Council to cover the costs for 2009/2010 financial year. As the District Council is the charging authority they will collect this on behalf of the Parish Council through the Council Tax.

The Parish Council has tried to keep their charge down but with the increased energy charges the cost of the Street Lighting has virtually doubled over the last few years.

We actually cost the Council Tax payer about £1.00 per week.

The Parish Council office is situated in the Village Hall on the High Street. We aim to provide an accessible service that links across the tiers of Local Government to address issues of concern to local people. The office is open Monday to Friday 9am—12 noon. No appointment is necessary.
