Studley Parish Council

Min: 137 Update of the closure of HSBC- Cllr P Beaman

Cllr P Beaman & Cllr Mrs M Rickhards had a meeting with HSBC and they confirmed that the bank will be closed in Studley. The closure is due to the falling footfall in the last 3 years. The following alternative has been put in place;

- Online banking training for existing customers at the Studley branch
- Existing customers will be able to use the post office for withdrawal and deposits at no extra charge.
- Looking for location to install an additional cash point machine in the Village.

10. District, County Council & Delegate Reports.

County Cllr C Rickhards report;

- I. West Midlands Combined Authority- The Council have voted to explore the option of joining the West Midlands Combined Authority as a Constituent. Officers of the Council are tasked with developing a full business case to be presented to the Council within 6 months.
- II. Grant- Council have decided to use additional grant from the government which amounts to almost £3 million in the next 2 years for the following projects;

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- Adult Care Technology
- Career Support
- Prevention of falls for the elderly

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- Mental Health issues
- Support for Library network
- Road safety education
- Family Support work
- Arson reduction team
- Cycling promotion

District Cllr J Kerridge report;

- I. Cllr Kerridge has asked SDC on the progress of the Co-op site compulsory purchase by SDC. SDC have admitted that progress had been slower than expected and that money to fund a detailed survey of the site to ascertain its true value had recently been agreed by the leader and portfolio holders Chris Saint & Lynda Organ.
- II. Cllr Kerridge has asked for a deferment of Clarke Green Farm application for Bed & Breakfast use in the Dutch barn so that a site visit can be carried out by members to appreciate other developments on Clarke Green Farm. This may not be possible due to "non-determination" issues but a site visit will occur before either of the other 2 applications are heard. Cllr Kerridge will try to ensure as much information on the site as a whole and its historic development, is available to members and officers.

District Cllr Mrs H Wright informed Council that Paul Lankester the Chief Executive of SDC has been made redundant. His post will be filled by 2 junior officers. Cllr Mrs H Wright is very sorry that he is leaving as he has always been very helpful and supportive with any issues concerning Studley.
