- Petition presented on the future of maintained nursery schools. There is currently a consultation exercise with three options, two of which pose the possibility of closures. The controlling group insisted there were no plans for closures.

 A motion on dropping the Fire & Rescue proposals was debated. Cllr Rickhards spoke on this. The motion was defeated. Cllr Hobbs (Port Folio holder) indicated that the matter was to be debated again at the July meeting of the Cabinet. He said 'other options' were being explored but did not elaborate.

Questions asked: what is meant by 'waste reduction' – Cllr Rickhards none the wiser. Finance is the problem with regard to PCSO's in schools. Concerns raised about maintained nursery schools which are for people on low incomes.

Graeme Smith, Chief Fire Officer came to Studley last week and met with Cllrs Mrs Wade, Beaman, McCarthy and the Clerk before visiting the Youth Club and the Library. He gave no indication as to the future of Studley Fire Service but made the point that needed to think creatively.

Report of Studley Allotments Association Meeting on Thursday, 29th April 2010 given by Cllr McCarthy

Summary:

- At Dunstall there are four applicants awaiting plots, a ½ plot is still free.
- Reports of pot holes caused by vehicles and also of vehicles travelling along the path too fast. Some plot holders are still leaving the gates open.
- One member wanted to keep six fowl, which is in the agreement and also two hives of bees. Two plot holders stated that they were allergic to stings others felt it would be in order to keep two hives, but wanted permission from the Parish Council before the go-ahead. It was stated that some Parish Councils refused permission for bee keeping.
- Some plots were a long way from water taps but the Association will install a tap at its own cost.
- On the matter of a termination and the three letter system, Cllr McCarthy suggested that the Parish Council should send copies to the Association Secretary also copies of Contracts issued.
- It was suggested that there should be a check on brambles growing through the hedges.
