10	Brickyard Lane. Gulley Grid now replaced but this gulley is now blocked Paul Cowell states this is "On the Radar" but gangs still pothole filling	W.C.C.	
11	Attend to Inspection Cover & Frame on Station Road outside 106	W.C.C.	
12	Re-surface Carriageway at entrance to Ridgeway Close to a depth of 4 metres <b>John Brown states this is now a wish list item may be included in budget for 2011/2012</b>	W.C.C.	
13	Resurface Lay-by between Ridgeway Close and Littlewood Green <b>See 12</b>	W.C.C.
