1. Litter bin missing from corner of Pool Road Car Park.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>To be replaced in 6 weeks</b>
2. Lectern sign to Pool Road Car Park badly damaged.	<b>SIP SIB</b>	<b>GL to ask PSW for quote</b>
3. Litter bins by bus shelter and outside Co-op entrance on Alcester Road to be replaced.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>AL to action</b>
4. Litter is still a problem in Pool Road car park and Millennium Green.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>AL to monitor. Litter picked once a week in the winter and twice per week in the summer.</b>
5. Pavements have been very dirty particularly pavements on Alcester Road. Studley in Bloom swept them 10 days ago.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>AL and SIB to monitor. New pavement sweeper to be available 1<sup>st</sup> August</b>
6. Yellow lines in Marble Alley cannot be seen because of dirt.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>AL to action. Done next morning</b>
7. Street name signs. Some have been replaced but many are rusty and	<b>SPC SDC</b>	<b>AL has ordered a new sign for Atcheson Close</b>

damaged. This was an adverse comment by HoE Judges last year.		
8. Land at rear of ex-Dixons, Alcester Road has heavy weed infestation which needs to be cleared. Agent to be informed. Rubbish being dumped.	<b>PCC</b>	<b>This is private land so SDC will not remove rubbish from here.</b>
9. General state of Brickyard Lane needs addressing, i.e. litter and fly tipping.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>AL inspected after the meeting. The fly tipping is on private land and SDC will not therefore remove it.</b>
10. Blocked drain in Brickyard Lane at first bend after Golf Club causing 50-60 meters of flooding	<b>WCC</b>	<b>JB to action</b>
11. Trim and clean up pavements on The Slough from Station Road to Green Lane.	<b>WCC</b>	<b>JB to monitor. Ongoing</b>
12. Footpath between Node Hill and Crooks Lane overgrown and in need of cutting back. Litter/dog bin required to replace burnt out one.	<b>SPC/WCC</b>	<b>Ongoing. Lesley has in hand <a href="mailto:paths@warwickshire.gov.uk">paths@warwickshire.gov.uk</a>. Lesley to get John to cut grass and check with SDC re bin. Ongoing. Litter bin was replaced last year.</b>
13. Street light on corner of Middletown Lane/Bromsgrove Road on Jubilee side, knocked over 6 months ago and not replaced.	<b>SPC/WCC</b>	<b>Lesley has investigated. This is Samborne's responsibility. Lesley to write to Samborne PC and report back.</b>
14. Alcester Road by petrol station, some large potholes/indents	<b>WCC/SPC</b>	<b>Ongoing</b>

15. Quality of grass cutting by SDC to be addressed. It is a very variable standard.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>In hand. New system – 9 cuts per year</b>
16. Tarmac in Gully (Needle Close to Pool Road carpark) lifting due to bamboo growing in school.	<b>WCC</b>	<b>GL to speak to the Infants School</b>
17. Wall around Co-op by crossing moving.	<b>SPC/WCC</b>	<b>SPC to contact Co-op and send copy of letter to WCC. Co-op state it is safe. Angela to investigate</b>
18. Tree Preservation Orders raised at recent SIP Meeting.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>SDC to look into process of dealing with TPOs. Ongoing</b>
19. Pool Road carpark badly infested with weeds	<b>SDC</b>	<b>Done. SIB to monitor</b>
20. Bottom of Needle Close/Alcester Road very bad surface and pot hole.	<b>WCC</b>	<b>JB has asked for photo when wet. It could be a Severn Trent issue.</b>
21. CCTV signs are illegible.	<b>SDC</b>	<b>GL to count and AL to action</b>
22. Wimpey Estate. Slurry seal is breaking up generally on pavements.	<b>WCC</b>	<b>JB to action Ongoing</b>
23. Flooding on The Slough is now a serious problem. Drains blocked causing 60 yards of flooding when heavy rain occurs.	<b>WCC</b>	<b>JB to action Ongoing</b>
