This will be free of charge and has been funded by Studley Parish Council with help from Stratford District Council. It is a 6 month trial to see how popular this facility for residents of Studley will be.

Any bulky item such as furniture is acceptable other than paint, old batteries, fluorescent tubes, bricks, concrete blocks etc. Please do not bring garden waste as this is collected in the green wheelie bins.

Please note as this is a household waste collection service no material will be accepted from commercially logged vehicles especially vans.
