WEST MIDLANDS SPATIAL STRATEGY

Phase 2 Draft Revision

Phase 2 of the WMRSS has focused on a range of issues which include housing figures. Studley Parish Council are concerned as Redditch has been designated as a 'Settlement of significant development' and will act as a focus for housing outside major urban areas.

6,600 houses are proposed 3,300 within Redditch and 3,300 adjacent to the town within Bromsgrove or Stratford on Avon Districts.

In both Stratford District Council Local Plan and Studley Parish Plan there is strong support to preserve the green belt areas around the village. It is very important that the land between Redditch and Studley be protected to prevent the urban sprawl of Redditch encroaching any further towards Studley.

In a recent report it was suggested that the A435 was now at capacity. As we have lost the chance of a bypass any further development will put extra pressure on the road which cannot be sustained.

The formal consultation is taking place from January 7th until 28th March 2008. Have your say.
