

They are a hard working group of volunteers who are often the first on the scene when an emergency occurs whether it is a road traffic accident or a problem in the home. They provide an important service and in some cases help save lives before an ambulance arrives on the scene. During the Christmas period last year they attended over 104 calls.





The **Youth Shield** award was presented to James Barry for the work he does as a member of the Young Fire Fighters and as a First Aider.

#### WALKING FOR HEALTH IN STUDLEY




Walks take place every Wednesday at 2pm on footpaths surrounding Studley and last for 1-2 hours. Walks suit all abilities and you can walk at your own pace.

#### **DOG FOULING**

Unfortunately dog fouling on footpaths and open spaces has become a problem again in Studley. Whilst most owners recognise their responsibilities there is a significant minority who do not seem to understand. Dog mess apart from being very unpleasant, can cause serious disease, particularly in children. If you are a dog owner please take a bag with you to clean up after your dog. The bag can be disposed of in a normal bin if you are unable to find a 'dog bin'.

Failure to clean up behind your dog can result in a fine of up to £1000.00

### Studley Citizens Advice Bureau Drop-in Service starts Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2012

The Outreach service of the Citizens Advice Bureau has been running every Tuesday for over a year now and over that time nearly 200 residents have been helped with about 400 separate issues. With the initial funding coming to an end, the service is changing from April. Thanks to the support of Studley Parish Council, the service will continue as a 'drop-in' on the first and third Tuesdays of every month, between 10am and 1pm.

This means you do not need to have an appointment just drop-in to the Village Hall on either the first or third Tuesday of every month and you will be able to get help from the Citizens Advice Bureau.

The Assessor at your initial meeting may well be able to resolve your problem by providing appropriate information or signposting you to another agency. If required you will be given a follow up appointment either at Alcester or Stratford for full advice.

### **Community Forums – Have your say**

Community Forums are public meetings led by the County Council and Stratford-on-Avon District Council to engage the public in council business. Warwickshire Police promote 'Safer Neighbourhoods through the Community Forums. Additionally the Safer Neighbourhood Teams hold a surgery prior to the forum during which time tea/coffee is available

Your Community Forum's next meeting is scheduled to take place on :-Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2012 at 7.30pm at Tanworth In Arden Village Hall, Vicarage Hill, Tanworth in Arden, B94 5AN you will be able to Influence Your Local Policing Priorities.

If you have a specific concern or problem, then drop in to the local surgery from 7.00pm—7.30pm where you will be able to speak to your Safer Neighbourhoods Policing Team, Councillors and Officers from Warwickshire County and Stratford-on-Avon District Councils.

### Studley 1<sup>st</sup> Responders

Studley 1<sup>st</sup> Responders are a small group of volunteers who often the first on the scene to provide treatment to the patient until a West Midland Ambulance Service resource arrives.

They have recently been adopted by the Redditch Lions who have given them support and funding. Thanks to a recent anonymous donation they have been able to secure a further vehicle which will enable them to provide greater coverage. A further Responder is currently being trained and should be operational by the summer. Training is being undertaken by one of the team to become qualified as a Medical 1<sup>st</sup> Responder which will enable him to administer medication to the patient.
