
# Housing

The Housing section of this questionnaire is principally focussed on 'making Studley a village of choice' and considers what types of houses we need rather than how many. The "How Many" will be determined through the Housing Needs Survey that accompanies this questionnaire.

The potential for new residential development in Studley is heavily constrained by Green Belt which surrounds the village, and limits the number of available suitable sites. The Green Belt is a specially designated area of countryside protected from most forms of development. It is protected to help stop urban sprawl, preserve the character of existing settlements by preventing coalescence and encourage development within existing built-up areas.

Applications for development in areas outside of the black line as shown on the 'Studley Inset Map' will need to show 'very special circumstance's before they will be permitted. Your views on this will help us to get a better understanding of what residents needs are and plan accordingly.






